This eminent Naturalist and Physician was born in
Marostica in the Republic of Venice in 1553.
He visited Egypt in 1580 chiefly with the view of pursuing
botanical and medical researches. He returned to Italy
in 1584 and became a Professor of Medical Philosophy
and of botany in the University of Padua and died
there in 1615.

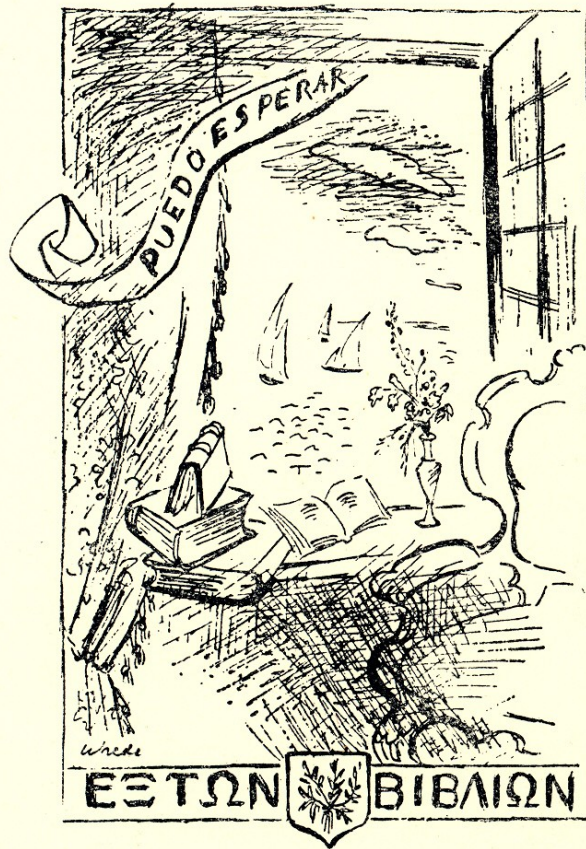

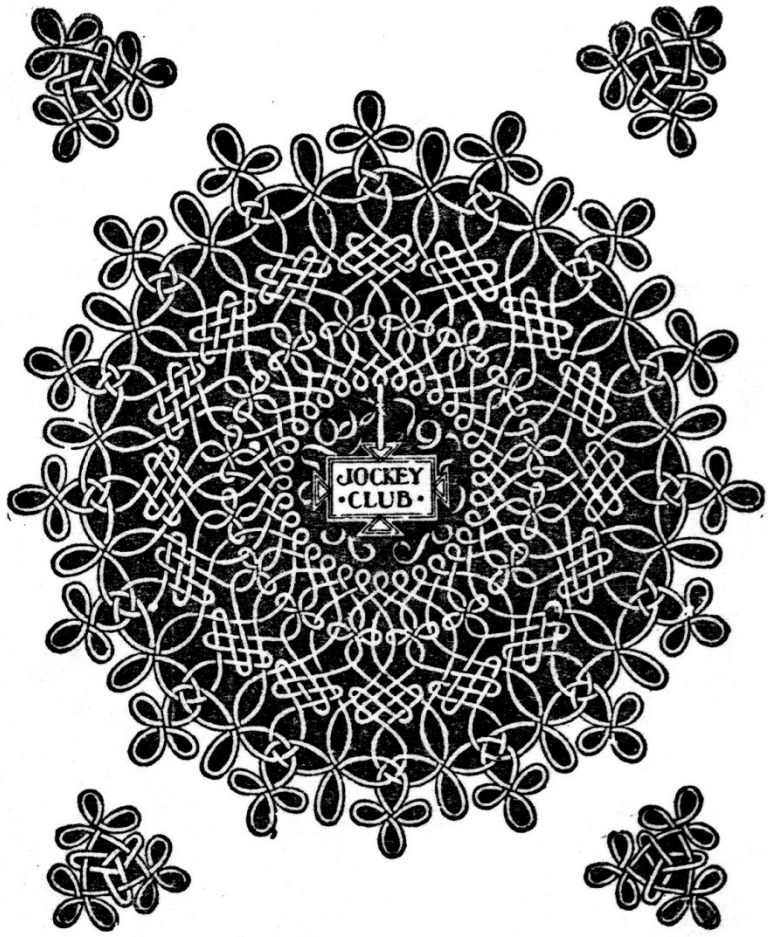

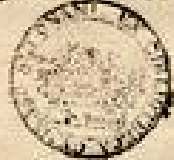
